

GENERAL NURSING & MIDWIFERY

Sanctioned Seats: 30

a. Preliminary Training Period

After admission, there shall be theory classes up to 14 weeks. During this period, the students will attend theory class (4 hrs.) & ward work (2 hrs.) for observations and supervised practice for patient care per day. No leave is granted during this period.

As per policy of the BMCHRC, a student will have to take an assessment examination towards the end of 14 weeks. By this examination, the students is assessed of her ability and aptitude towards nursing, based, on adjustment, personality, interest, health as well as her performance in the examination (written and practical). The students are required to secure 50% marks in written and practical in examination.

b. Objectives

- (i) To help the student to acquire the required knowledge and skills and a sound attitude towards life and the nursing profession.
- (ii) To prepare the student as a professional nursing practitioner in community health.
- (iii) To enable the student to take her rightful place in society as a professional.
- (iv) To enable the student to actively participate in providing quality medical care.
- (v) To prepare the students to keep pace with latest professional and technological developments and use these are providing nursing care to the society.
- (vi) To help the students in their personal & professional developments so that they are able to make maximum contribution to the society as a useful and productive individuals and efficient nurses.
- (vii) To help the students to develop the ability to co-ordinate with the members of health team in the prevention of disease, promotion of health and rehabilitation of the sick.

c. Details

- (i) The theoretical and practical training course are recognized by, and are in accordance with the rules and regulations of, the Rajasthan State Nursing Council. All students are required to take the examinations conducted by this Council.
- (ii) Council examinations are held at the end of the first, second and third year followed by internship of six months and final examination. An internal examination is held prior to the Council examination.
- (iii) Those students who pass the Council examination are promoted to next class.
- (iv) Failures: If a student fails her Council examination, her promotion to the next class and her eligibility to continue the course will depend on the Rajasthan State Nursing Council and Indian Nursing Council rules prevalent at that time.
- (v) During her training period a student will be assigned duties with progressively increasing responsibilities under the supervision of qualified staff nurses. A broad general nursing & midwifery training will be given to students and they will be rotated through as many departments as possible either within the main hospital or at its associates units like the SDM Hospital. They are also liable to be assigned duties at peripheral health facilities sponsored by the Santokbha Durlabhji Trust, Mahatma Gandhi and National Institute of Medical Sciences like Rural & Urban Health Centers, Health check up camps leprosy home etc.
