CLASS ROOMS

There are high-tech classrooms to accommodate students in each class. The rooms are well ventilated with proper lighting system, equipped with projectors. New Technologies with LCD Projector is provided to students to enable them to give power point presentations.

LIBRARY

The College has very rich library with variety of latest editions from Indian and foreign authors, magazines, reference books, national & international nursing journals etc. from which they get exposure to latest up date knowledge in the field. Audio visual aids along with internet facilities are provided for the convenience of the students and staff. Soft copies of many books are available in the Library. Comfortable seating arrangements for students and staff with proper arrangements of related infrastructure are available.

LABORATORIES

All nursing practice laboratories consist of modern equipments. Nutrition laboratory have facilities for imparting basic knowledge about food and to practice in cooking according to disease aspects. Community nursing and Obstetrics laboratory have all modern articles for practicing nursing procedure in a community set up.

COMPUTER LAB

The College has its own computer lab with networking facility. To access data from various sources, internet facility has been provided for the convenience of faculty and post graduate students.

CLINICAL EXPERIENCE

The College has its own parental hospital: Bhagwan Mahaveer Cancer Hospital and Research Centre, Jaipur, a super specialty Hospital in the State. For community Health Nursing and for clinical experience in other related fields like orthopedic, cardiology, pediatric, psychiatric nursing practical experience is provided Govt. Jaipuria Hospital, Sanganer PHC, Khandaka Hospital Sirsi Road, Adrash Hospital Sanganer respectively. Accommodation facility is available in Triple Seated, Double Seated for B.Sc & G.N.M. Students and Single Room facility for M.Sc. Students and nominal boss.

HOSTEL FACILITY

The College has hostel facilities for girls. Rooms are available to accommodate three students and also for two students, as per choice of the student. Separate common dining and recreation room is available. Hostel warden is posted to look after the internal administration and day to day discipline of the hostel.

TRANSPORTATION

The College has its own transportation facility for taking the students to the attached hospitals as well as rural and urban training centers, escorted by teaching staff.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

The College provides proper facilities for students to participate in extra-curricular activities. Students are encouraged to participate in various exhibitions, workshops and seminars under the supervision of teaching faculty. One member of the faculty helps them and tries to maximize individual participation. Educational tours are also conducted by the College for post graduate students for pursuit of their academic curriculum. Cultural programmes are also organized by the College to provide talent exposure of the students.

M.Sc. NURSING

The students are admitted in Medical Surgical Nursing specialty in the course of M.Sc. Nursing.

Complete details of terms and conditions of examination and declaration of results have been given in the *Part B of Examination Form*.

Number of seats: The College has sanctioned strength of ten seats , out of which five seats are nominated by the Rajasthan University of Health Sciences and *remaining five seats are filled in by the College for which, application form is attached herewith*. Entrance examination is conducted and admissions are made on the basis of merit of the examination.

Minimum qualification required for admission:

- Must have passed B.Sc. Nursing / Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing or its equivalent.
- Registered Nurse and Registered Midwife
- Medically fit
- No upper age limit.

Duration: The M.Sc. course is full time course with two years duration.

DETAILS OF EXAMINATION

The Examination will be held on *28-12-2008 (Sunday)* at BMCHRC College of Nursing, Jaipur.

- (a) The Pre-M.Sc. (Nursing) Examination shall be of the standard of B.Sc. (Nursing) Examination of Rajasthan University of Health Science and shall cover all the subject of the B.Sc. Nursing Course.
